Course Overview	JA1 is a class for zero-beginner level international students with no prior Japanese. The first step is learning <i>Hiragana</i> and <i>Katakana</i> . The second step is for learning Japanese grammar, vocabulary and expressions according to beginner-level texts, and improving speaking skills by using them. Kanji are gradually introduced from Lesson 3 of the text.		
Course Objectives	The course aims to have students acquire the following abilities: (1) Writing and Pronunciation of <i>Hiragana</i> and <i>Katakana</i> correctly. (2) Vocabulary based on the progression of the texts. (3) Grammar skills based on the progression of the texts.		
Prerequisite	Before taking this course, you should be able to read and write <i>Hiragana</i> . Preparation before class and after class assignments must be done.
